COVID-19 STATEMENT

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, EHS students learned remotely from March 16, 2020 through the end of the school year on May 15, 2020. We offered both virtual and in-person classes in 2020 - 2021. Last year, we resumed to all in-person teaching. Students were awarded official grades, which appear on their transcript and are included in their EHS GPA. Individual challenges due to the pandemic are addressed in students' recommendation letters from the college counselor.
